# QUALIFYING FOR ALPS

The ALPS placement process is composed of three parts:

- A parent recommendation in the form of this application.
- Above grade-level Iowa Assessment in reading and math.
- On grade-level Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT).

In general, students who qualify for the ALPS program place at or above the 85-90<sup>th</sup> percentile in national scoring.

#### SPACE AVAILABILITY

- Space is very limited in most grades at most schools.
- If a student qualifies for ALPS, the ALPS office will notify the family of current placement options.
- When no space is available, the qualifying student will be placed on a waiting list.
- Students who are not placed in ALPS for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply for ALPS for the next year.

#### SUMMER TESTING DATES

- June Tuesday, June 4 AND Wednesday, June 5.
  - AM and PM sessions available on each day.
  - Students must attend a testing session on each day.
- July Tuesday, July 30 AND Wednesday, July 31.
  - 12:30 p.m. 3:00 p.m.
  - Students must attend the testing session on each day.
- Of note: Testing was originally planned for early August, but is now scheduled for late July.

# **TESTING FEE**

- A \$35 testing fee is due with each ALPS application.
- Pay by check, money order, or credit card in the Teaching & Learning Department at the address above.
- OR
- Payment can also be made online through jordansdut.governmentwindow.com/estore/district\_office/testing.html
   If paying online, include the confirmation number on your payment receipt with the application.
- Fee waivers are available for those who qualify for free/reduced lunch.
  - Attach a copy of the verification letter from Nutrition Services with your application.

# TEST RESULTS AND PLACEMENT NOTIFICATION

• A letter with test results and placement outcome will be mailed to the applicant's home approximately two weeks after testing is completed.

#### TRANSPORTATION

• If placement is offered, parents are responsible for transportation to and from the ALPS school. Busing is not provided. Parents can choose to be included on an optional carpool list.
