Side by Side Reading Fiction/Nonfiction Bud, Not Buddy

During the month of February, we will be reading *Bud*, *Not Buddy*. This historical fiction novel, written by Christopher Paul Curtis, is a time-piece set during The Great Depression Era/The Jazz Age. In order to fully grasp the setting and appreciate the plot, we need to familiarize ourselves with the time period. Therefore, you will read a nonfiction book to read "Side by Side" with *Bud*, *Not Buddy*.

A book about your chosen topic is due on Monday, February 7th for check-in. It is very important that you meet this due date since the Side by Side reading will be completed in school. You will have AT LEAST ten minutes a day, sometimes more, spent reading your nonfiction book. Don't forget to apply the five finger rule. It will help you find a book appropriate for your reading level. If you are having difficulty finding a book please ask for help a few of days before it is due.
